About the performers:
Judy Meiselman: Her rich, full voice and talent for getting inside a lyric give a special artistry to her singing of the blues, gospel, and contemporary songs. She sings with deep feeling and verve. Judy has traveled and performed in Italy and South America.
Marie Mularczyk O'Connell: A multi-talented performer who sings with strength and richness, she brings her delightful instrumental skill and vitality to each and every performance. Marie has also performed with Soldier's Fancy and The Broadside Balladeers, and she can be heard on the CD, *Ballads, Broad sides and Bad News*.
Linda Prager: Linda's powerful yet floating voice has delighted audiences from New York to London, singing everything from the blues to Gilbert and Sullivan. Audiences are moved by the emotion that comes through her singing. She has performed with the Village Light Opera Group.
Robbie Wedeen: A singer/songwriter of warmth and wit, her songs express a modern view of women within the creative vitality of the American folk tradition. She has released a CD of original songs, *Bluejay Gold*, and a CD of 18th-century folk music, *Freedom's Proud Song*. She also performs with the country and bluegrass string band Triple Play All-Stars, which released a CD titled *Having a Ball*.
